Which car museum is in the same city?



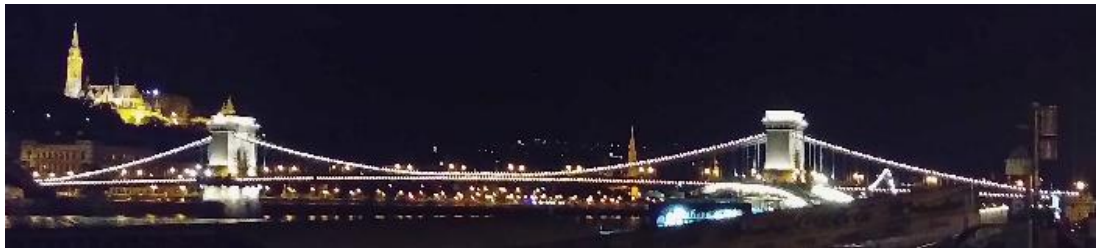

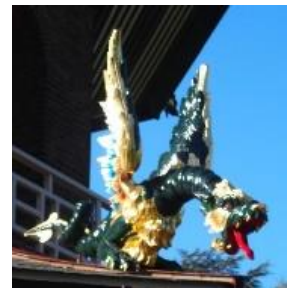


8. There was an Escher exhibition in Lisbon. Where is Escher from?
